COLLEGE PROFILE

The college was established in 1992 by the ‘Guhagar Education Society’ with the following vision statement in mind: “Dynamic Education for Social Transformation”

The journey began with introduction of Commerce faculty in 1992 which was followed by establishment of Arts faculty in 1998 and subsequent introduction of science faculty in 2010. The college is government aided, permanently affiliated to the University of Mumbai, UGC 2(f)-12(B) recognized and accredited by NAAC with B+ grade. At present the college runs following undergraduate courses:

- Arts (B.A.): With electives among Marathi, History, Politics & Economics
- Commerce (B Com): With electives among Business Management & Accountancy
- Science (B. Sc.):
 1. Single Major: Chemistry, Microbiology
 2. Double Major: Physics-Geology, Physics-Mathematics
 3. B. Sc. IT

Along with these degree courses the college also runs few certificate courses on need basis at institutional level such as:

- Certificate course in Medical Lab Technology
- Certificate course in Astronomy
- Certificate course in Tally ERP
- Certificate course in Journalism
- Foundation course for Govt. Jobs



It has a strong NSS unit, which has received awards by both University of Mumbai & Government of Maharashtra as well. The students actively participate in the University Zonal level cultural competitions

and bag medals every year. The college also has a dedicated gymkhana with necessary facilities. At present the building is equipped with Wi-Fi connectivity with access for all and separate fiber-optic cable with 100 Mbps speed. The college has a three-story building (G+2) with 12 classrooms (of which two are digital classrooms), one seminar hall, a library, 6 science laboratories and one computer laboratory. The building is located on a 7-acre hilly terrain allocated for the college surrounded by greenery and offers a picturesque sea view through the windows of the upper floors.

At present the college has 18 teaching staff members in the aided section, 4 teaching staff members in the un-aided section and 12 non-teaching staffs employed in the office, library and laboratories.

All the teaching staff members are fully qualified and duly approved by the University of Mumbai, of which 8 are Ph. D. holders with one Ph. D. guide. Two staff members are appointed syllabus framing and paper setting panels of the University of Mumbai. Seven teachers have successfully completed the Minor research projects funded by the University of Mumbai. Five teachers are currently pursuing their Ph. D. and active in research.

The students of the college predominantly belong to the rural region of Guhagar Tehsil and reside in remote places. In most of the cases they are the first-generation learners. They travel on an average 40~60 km daily by MSRTC buses to attend the college. The college provides them the necessary opportunities and exposure by organizing study tours, field visits, seminars and projects. Guhagar being a tourist place, some students turn towards entrepreneurship in hospitality industry and many others opt for govt. jobs through competitive exams or private jobs in Mumbai or chemical industries in Lote MIDC & RGPPL. Recently, students have also started to enroll for higher education due to constant encouragement, guidance and support from the college.

With the introduction of the National Education Policy 2020, the college strives to upgrade and strengthen its infrastructure and introduce modern teaching-learning methodologies. For the larger benefit of the students, it envisions some major projects such as a separate library building and auditorium/multipurpose hall, development of eco-friendly premises, upgrading of science laboratories and establishment of a separate computer access center etc. in near future.

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INFRASTRUCTURE

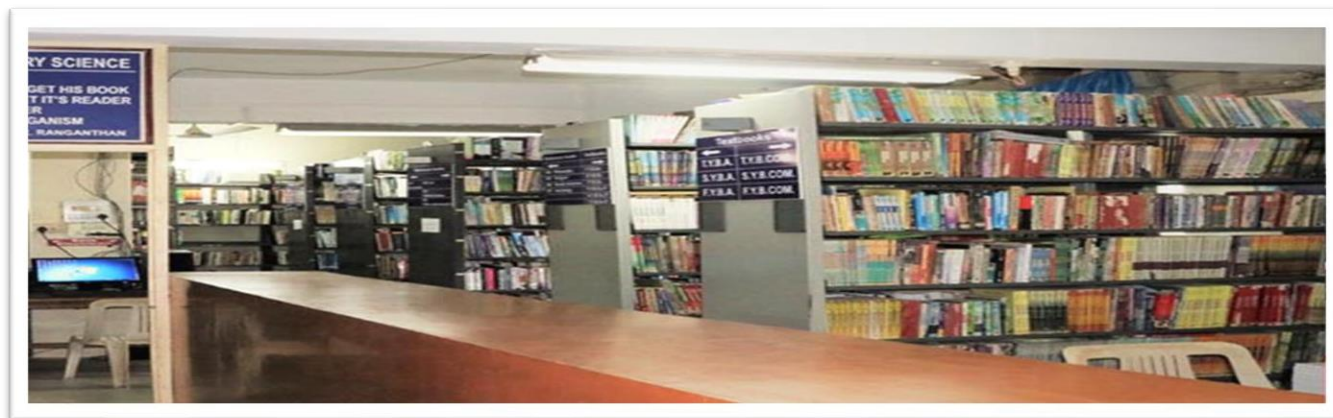
Khare-Dhere-Bhosale College of arts, commerce & science provides infrastructure to facilitate the education process and enhance the learning ability of the students. It aims at developing intellectual capabilities and an understanding of the relationship between education and the real world.

Library

The Sadanand Sudam Patil Library (The Central Library) of G. B. Tatha Tatyasaheb Khare Commerce, Parvatibai Gurupad Dhere Arts & Shri. Mahesh Janardan Bhosale Science College, Guhagar, was established in the year 1992. Since then, the library has made consistent progress in terms of collection of books, periodicals, CDs, E-resources, services and has provided Infrastructure. The library plays a vital role in supporting teaching and learning activities. It is an invaluable source of information to complement the course curriculum as well as enrich user's self-development. The library is computerized with INFLIBNET SOUL 2.0 Software and subscribed various E- Resources under INFLIBNET N-List Programme.

All registered students, faculty members and non-teaching staff of the college are entitled to register as members of the library and to use the facilities & services offered for the purpose of their academic, research and administrative work. Use of Library facilities and services implies acceptance of Library rules and procedures.

The library collection consists of 13000+ books and 55 Journals and Magazines covering the subject areas corresponding to the academic programmes and activities of the college. The books are arranged according to the Dewey decimal classification system.



Book bank scheme for socially backward students

The library runs backward class book bank scheme out of aid form University of Mumbai. Books on returnable term are given to the socially backward class students for the whole academic year.

Gymkhana

Gymkhana Department of our college engages various sports activities. The health of any institution is summing total of health of all its constituent members. The extra –curricular activities and sports give scope

for their hidden talents in cultural activities and sports. The institution has provided a standard playground for sports like volley-ball, Kho-Kho, Kabaddi, Cricket, etc. 200-meter track for outdoor games is also provided. For indoor games like Badminton, Chess, Table Tennis, Carom etc. the required facilities are also made available. The institution facilitates the admission of students, who had taken part and participated at Taluka, District, Region, State, All India inter University level sports and cultural activities, by giving them concession in admission fees. They are motivated to take part in intra college sports and cultural activities and also trained in respective sports and cultural activities to elevate their performance in respective stages and bring out hidden talent in them to groom them for national and international sports activities. Students of this institution who comes out as winners, are suitably rewarded by institution by providing them sports kit, blazers and certificates at annual social gathering at the hands of renowned personalities.

Grahak Bhandar

A separate room with necessary furniture is provided to the Students Consumer Co-operative Store. Various educational and stationary material is made available in concessional rates for students and teachers. All operations of Grahak Bhandar are run by students under regulation of college committee.

Bharat Ratna Dr. B.R Ambedkar Seminar Hall

This well-furnished facility can accommodate up to 80 students and is frequently used for seminars, talks and lectures by external professionals.

ICT Facilities

The institute is very careful for promoting the use of various ICT resources for teaching and learning by faculty members as well as students. The library is one of the participants of UGC, INFLIBNET N-LIST Programme which makes available foreign peer reviewed journals and e-books. The training programs are regularly held at college entitling the use of online educational resources for faculty and students. College promotes extensive use of LCD projectors, PPT presentations etc. wherever required for effective student-centered teaching and learning processes. Few departments have been allotted separate computer and internet connection which is used for conducting lectures and practical. Technology up gradation is practiced actively in office administration and also in library management of college. The library has introduced barcode system for circulation of library books. All the books of library are with barcode stickers and computer data of each student is maintained in the library.

Science laboratories

The department of Basic Sciences features six laboratories for Chemistry, Microbiology, Physics, Geology, Botany and Zoology. These labs are adequately equipped to serve the students with a scientific temperament and enable them to pursue projects and research. With the latest instruments and facilities in the laboratories, the students perform various scientific experiments in the respective fields in the labs.



Computer Lab/ IT Lab

The computer lab is designed with state-of-the-art technology and is equipped with all the major application software's for imparting quality education. The internet equipped lab is open beyond academic hours to meet the computing needs of the students. Effective lab assistance is provided during lab sessions to give a helping hand to students in handling problems they might encounter and to equip them to excel in the practical process of programming.

Women Development Cell (WDC)

The WDC believes in empowerment of girl students. The Cell encourages the students develop into confident individuals.

Anti-Ragging Committee

The College has formed the Anti-Ragging Committee as per the guidelines of the University Grants Commission and the University of Mumbai. Students involved in offence of Ragging will be strictly punished by the College Administration.

The cultural needs of the students are taken care of through various activities such as music, dance, drama etc. by the cultural Committee. The College encourages and supports cultural festivals organized by students.

National Service Scheme (NSS)

The college has a vibrant NSS Unit that encourages the development of the students into responsible citizens of the society. Students under the guidance of Programme officers are actively involved in a number of programmes that are carefully monitored by the NSS Unit of University of Mumbai.

Department of Lifelong Learning & Extension (DLLE)

To facilitate the sensitization of the students to the socio-cultural realities, the College has introduced the extension work program offered by the Department of Life Long Learning and Extension of University of Mumbai. The Cadets are given basic military training in small arms and parades. The officers and cadets have no liability for active military service once they complete their course but are given preference over normal candidates during selections based on the achievements in the corps. 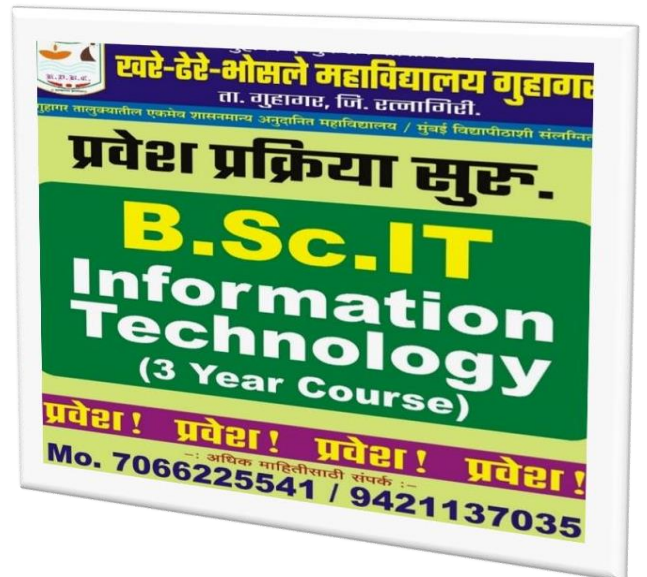

What is Academic Bank of Credits?

As per National Education Policy 2020, Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) is a national-level facility to promote flexibility of curriculum framework and provide academic mobility of students with appropriate credit transfer mechanism and provide academic learning path to attain a Degree/Diploma/PG-diploma, etc, working on the principle of multiple entry-multiple exit as well as any-time, any-where, and any-level of learning.

How it works?

Credits get deposited at Institution A → Transfer of Credits to ABC → Redeem Credits at Institution B

Process of Sign Up for Students

- ★ Students can visit abc.gov.in and click on the **My Account** tab.
- ★ Click on the **Student** tab and register to create ABC Account.
- ★ Students can also create ABC ID through **DigiLocker**.

Benefits

- Single window Credit Transfer
- Enable Student mobility
- Promote Transparency
- Academic flexibility

It is a credit facility originally envisioned by the Government of India in the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020. The scheme has the provisions of creating a digital infrastructure that will store the academic credits earned by the students of various higher education institutes within the country.

The ABC will be entrusted with the responsibilities such as opening, closing, and verifying the individual academic accounts of students. It'll also be responsible to gather the academic credits earned by the students from their respective higher education institutions, verify the credits, store the credits, transfer or redeem such credits, and promote them as and when required among its stakeholders.

Students will have to manually open an account with the Academic Bank of Credit of India and abide by the standard operating procedures as communicated to them by the ABC along with a unique ID that identifies a student's account with the ABC.

To generate ABC IDs through one of the following options.

Option A

- (i) Visit on www.abc.gov.in
- (ii) Click on my account-Student
- (iii) For New User-Click on “Sign up for Meri Pehchan”
- (iv) Enter Mobile number, you will get OTP on registered mobile number.
- (v) Fill all necessary details and click on verify
- (vi) Students will get ABC ID. Get these details for college record.

Option B

- (i) Sign in to Digi locker by visiting on www.digilocker.gov.in (can be done using Mobile or Aadhar)
- (ii) Go to search documents.
- (iii) Go to education section
- (iv) Search for ABC ID widget
- (v) Click on widget to generate and download ABC ID
- (vi) Student will get ABC ID. Get these details for college record.

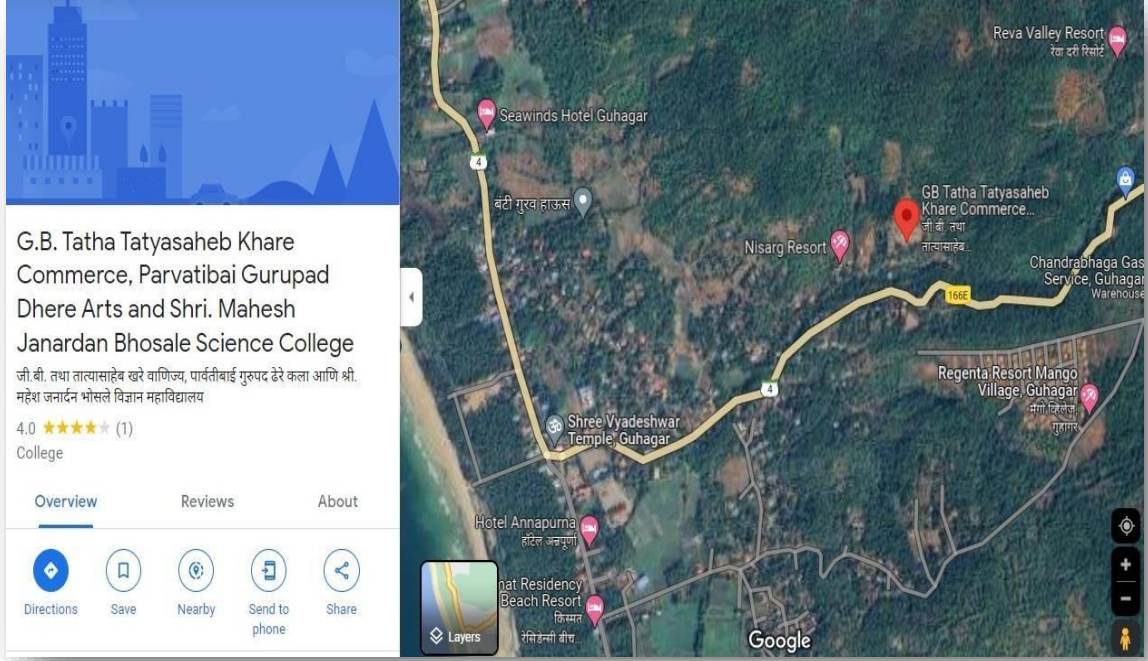
